

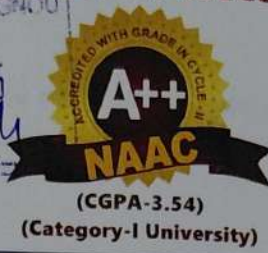

As per UN estimates, more than 150,000 deaths occur annually worldwide due to climate-related causes. In this context, Paryavaran Sanrakshan Gatividhi (PSG)—a nationwide organization dedicated to environmental awareness and action has been conducting the National Students Paryavaran Competition (NSPC) since 2022. The response has been phenomenal:

- 2022: Over 8.46 lakh students from 55,000 schools participated.

- 2024: More than 7.09 lakh students from 45,022 institutions took part, with participants from 107 foreign countries.






