The evaluation strategy will be: Guided experiments 70 %, Unguided experiment; 30 % The lab course is of 2 credits which have to be conducted in a week's time. Right now, the experiments are to be conducted in offline mode.

The details of TEE are as given below are also given in every lab course printed material as well as on egyankosh.

## <u>IMPORTANT</u>

- Attendance is compulsory in the Laboratory course work held generally at the study centre.
- The Laboratory Course is worth 2 credits to be completed over 7 days duration:
  - 6 days of Guided Laboratory work
  - 1 day for the Unguided Laboratory work
- To successful complete the laboratory course you will have to pass (at least 35% marks) in the Guided and Unguided components separately.
