The conduct of examination and evaluation of the performance of the learners play a very vital role in educational system because, without evaluation, the educational system cannot be run smoothly and successfully. Student Evaluation Division (SED) overall coordinates the following activities related to examination and evaluation:

1. Conduct of Term End Examination
2. Practical Examination
3. Evaluation of Assignments
4. Evaluation of Project and Other Components
5. Workshop and Seminar

The Term-end Examination, December 2024 for the programmes under E-Vidyabharti project will be conducted **online in proctored mode from 09th December, 2024 to 09th January, 2025**. The University has extended the facility for the students of E-Vidyabharti to appear in proctored mode. The examination has been scheduled in such a manner that it is neither too early nor too late, considering time zone variations of different places, where the learners have been registered, keeping the time zone variation in mind and adjusting the time difference of **1.5 hrs to 5.5 hrs from Indian Standard Time (IST)**.

Please note that the Examination will be conducted from 12.30 PM to 03:30 PM (IST) Morning session and 04.30 PM to 07:30 PM (IST) Evening session as per the date sheet being sent to you by mail.

The date sheet with IST Time and the difference of time from IST for various time zones is enclosed. The detailed instructions and the action to be taken by the students to appear in the examination are provided hereunder:

Type of Paper : Objective and Descriptive

Mode of Paper : Proctored Mode

Minimum IT Infrastructure to appear in the Examination for E-Vidya Bharti Project students for Term-end-Examination, December, 2024

- Computer with Keyboard and Mouse
- Internet Speed (Minimum 20 Mbps bandwidth per 50-seater) (user of Mobile data is not permitted)
- Web-Cam
- Safe Exam Browser 3.8.0 (Software) for the online exam will be provided by IGNOU and the same will be downloaded by the Student during the Mock Test/Walk through before the Examination)

Instructions to the Learners

1. Download Safe Exam Browser 3.8.0 for Windows 10 and 11 (https://safeexambrowser.org/download_en.html#Windows)
2. Install Safe Exam Browser on your PC/Laptop/AIO
 - If you are unable to install default setup file choose OS architecture specific file from https://sourceforge.net/projects/seb/files/seb/SEB_3.8.0/
 - Try to install using new downloaded file
3. Close all remote and other applications except one web browser
4. Login to <https://ignouexam.samarth.ac.in> with your credentials
5. After First Login, Please Change your default password.
6. Visit your [Profile](#) then click on the Edit Profile link.
7. Upload your latest/current Profile Picture (You can click using the system webcam and upload) then update your profile.
8. Go to your course/exam and click to Launch Safe Exam Browser
9. Safe Exam Browser will open a login Page if all SEB requirements are met
10. Re-login with the same credentials

11. Click on Attempt Exam Now
12. Read Notification on plagiarism, webcam/camera, and Time limit carefully
13. Click on Start Attempt, it will open in new pop-up windows, maximize the window and start attempting Questions.
14. Make Sure your camera is on during the exam otherwise you will not be able to attempt further questions and the Paper will be submitted automatically after the duration of the paper.

Note for those who are unable to login: If you are not able to login you can reset your password on your own, follow the following instructions for the same:

- Enter the Email address which was provided at the time of admission.
- Click on Search then click on continue (You will receive an email with link. Click on the link and enter your new password twice then click on save changes button).

MOCK TEST: To ensure that the learners do not face any issue while attempting the Term-End-Examination in proctored mode, a Mock Test will be conducted by SED for all the eligible and registered learners.

It is desired that all the learners should attempt the MOCK TEST which will be in examination like conditions so as to facilitate and resolve any problem faced by the learners. The FAQs regarding the examination are attached with these guidelines. The learners will have to login with their credentials as provided in para above to attempt both the MOCK TEST and Term-End-Examination. The MOCK TEST will be conducted approximately a week prior to commencement of Term-End-Examination.

TYPE OF QUESTION PAPERS/PATTERN OF EXAMINATION

Type of Question Papers/Pattern of Examination will be sent separately.

DURATION OF EXAMINATION

The Maximum duration of Examination will be 03 hours. However, exact duration will be that mentioned on the question paper. The exam will begin at **12.30 PM to 03:30 PM (IST) Morning session and 04.30 PM to 07:30 PM (IST) Afternoon Session** on the scheduled date. The students are requested to login and appear in the exam according to their time zone of their places accordingly.

Further, learners are also advised to follow strictly the following instructions during online examination:

1. Wearing of Mask is not allowed.
2. The face of learner must be visible.
3. Login in with different IP or multiple system (PC/Laptop/AIO) is not allowed.
4. The same photo should be there on the Profile of the learner that was uploaded during admission time.
5. Use of Earphone/Headphone/any Bluetooth devices are also not allowed.

6. No person other than the learner (examinee) should remain present within the room during examination.
7. Camera/Webcam should remain operative during the examination, if it is disabled or not working, learner will not be able to attempt the exam further.
8. Internet connectivity is mandatory during the examination.
9. Power backup.
10. In case of failure of internet connectivity/power backup, learner will not be compensated for it.

Therefore, the students of E-Vidya Bharti are requested to comply with the above so as to undergo a fair and peaceful examination. Those students who are not able to appear in the Term-end Examination, June 2024 for any reason, they can appear in the ensuing Term-end Examination to be held in December 2024.
